Bruce Greyson, MD Beyond *After*: All the News That's Not Fit to Print Thursday 10:30 - 11:30 am

A couple of years ago, Bruce Greyson published a book called *After*, summarizing his half century exploring near-death experiences. Since then, he has received a number of e-mails from people who were disappointed that he didn't discuss in his book a specific topic that they thought he either didn't mention or shortchanged. Many of those topics were specific religious or spiritual traditions, philosophical perspectives, or neurophysiological models that they thought could explain NDEs. In this presentation, Bruce will review some of the many aspects of NDEs that disappointed readers thought he should have included, focusing on the most commonly mentioned ermation.

topics: God, animals, reincarnation, the conflict between science and spirituality, and the ultimate meaning of NDEs.

Dr. Bruce Greyson is the Chester Carlson Professor Emeritus of Psychiatry and Neurobehavioral Sciences at the University of Virginia. He co-founded the International Association for Near-Death Studies (IANDS), and for 27 years edited the Journal of Near-Death Studies, the only scholarly journal dedicated to near-death research. Through his research, he has discovered common and universal themes in near-death experiences that go beyond neurophysiological or cultural interpretations, as well as patterns of consistent aftereffects on individuals' attitudes, beliefs, values, and personalities. He was a co-editor of The Handbook of Near-Death Experiences: Thirty Years of Investigation. His most recent book, After: A Doctor Explores What Near-Death Experiences Reveal About Life and Beyond, is his first trade book bringing his scientific research to a popular audience.



Jeffrey Mishlove, PhD The Return of the PK (psychokinetic) Man Friday 10:30 - 11:30 am

Jeffrey Mishlove's book, *The PK Man*, published in 2000, describes a 10-year field investigation of Ted Owens (1920-1987), a man who demonstrated unusual macro-psychokinetic abilities. Owens claimed that UFO contacts were responsible for his ability to mentally influence large-scale weather systems as well as UFO sightings and other events. In December 2022, Jeffrey received a message from a *New Thinking Allowed* viewer in Germany who claimed that Ted Owens had reached out to him from the afterlife while he was meditating. In this session,

Jeffrey will report on the results of that communication.

Jeffrey Mishlove, PhD, is host and producer of the New Thinking Allowed *channel on YouTube. He is author of* The Roots of Consciousness, Psi Development Systems, and The PK Man. *He is the recipient of the only doctoral diploma in "Parapsychology" ever awarded by an accredited university (University of California, Berkeley, 1980). Between 1986 and 2002 he hosted and co-produced the original Thinking Allowed public television series. He is the Grand Prize winner of the 2021 Bigelow Institute Essay Competition regarding the best evidence for survival of human consciousness after permanent bodily death. Eben Alexander, MD, and Karen Newell Love as an Antidote to the Illusion of Separation Saturday 10:30 - 11:30 am

A fundamental lesson of what happens when we die is the understanding that we are all in this together, bound through loving connections here on Earth, into the afterlife, and beyond. The science of entanglement verifies that these interconnections are real and not illusory. The human qualities of empathy and compassion, in their purest sense, are directly derived from that sense of oneness. Altruistic acts provide a feeling of connection, enabling us to transcend the sense that we are separate. This ultimate oneness we share emphasizes why caring for the least, the last, and the lost is vital to our modern society, in order to live up to its spiritual promise.

Eben Alexander, MD, was an academic neurosurgeon for over 25 years, including 15 years at the Brigham & Women's Hospital, Children's Hospital, and Harvard Medical School in Boston. In 2008, during a week-long coma from an inexplicable brain infection, he experienced a transcendental near-death experience (NDE) that completely transformed his worldview. A pioneering scientist and modern thought leader in the emerging science that acknowledges the primacy of consciousness in the universe, he is the author of the New York Times #1 bestseller Proof of Heaven, The Map of Heaven, and Living in a Mindful Universe. http://ebenalexander.com/

Based on quotes of more than 100 NDErs one can draw two important conclusions. The first is that LOVE is the most important thing there is and that Unconditional Love awaits us when our body dies and our consciousness is released. The second message is that we are at least very thoroughly INTERCONNECTED with one another, with other animals, with nature, and in fact with all that exists. However, if we take a closer look at what many NDErs say, the conclusion could be more extreme than just this interconnectedness. It should probably be that we are all ONE, seen from another dimension. Love is what seems to bind us. People would see this truth if they

would appreciate the circumstantial evidence in veridical observations. They would then be inspired to more loving actions, and humanity could really take a beneficial next step forward.

Robert Christophor Coppes holds a PhD in economics. His conviction that NDEs are true spiritual experiences dates back to 1979 after reading Raymond Moody's Life after Life. His most recent book contains hundreds of quotes of more than 100 NDErs, and he says that in fact NDErs are the writers of this book. In 2006, he wrote a book in which he compared the essences of NDEs with those of five world religions. A few years later he wrote Messages from The Light, which was also translated in Dutch and German.

William is a global leader in shared death studies and end-of-life phenomenon. He teaches methods to facilitate the shared death experience and to assist experiencers in meaningfully integrating their experiences. His work is informed by his two NDEs and a variety of shared crossings. William's book, entitled At Heaven's Door: What Shared Journeys to the Afterlife Teach About Dying Well and Living Better, is published by Simon & Schuster.

Monica Williams, MD, is a board-certified emergency physician who is on staff at one of the largest emergency departments in the nation, Huntsville Hospital, where she is also the Medical Director for Advanced Care Planning and End of Life Education Programs. Dr. Monica is a passionate author and keynote speaker whose focus is empowering patients and families in critical and end-of-life decision-making. Her book, It's OK to Die and companion website are tools devoted to transforming the end of life into a time of peace, closure, and healing. Dr. Monica has lectured from Princeton to LA, and her work has appeared in the New York Times, the Health Around the Web Column, and the Washington Post. She has appeared on the Emmy Award winning TV show The Doctors, and her work has been adopted by UCLA's Center for Integrative Oncology. William Peters and Dr. Monica are, respectively, the principal investigator and medical director for the Shared Crossing Research Initiative which collects and studies shared crossings. Their works have been published in the American Journal of Hospice and Palliative Medicine and the Omega – Journal of Death Studies.







Near-death experiencers sometimes disclose their NDEs to healthcare providers, including physicians. The early period right after an NDE may be accompanied by emotional distress and shock, so support and validation is especially important at that point. Research shows that approximately one-third of disclosures happen within a day of an NDE and that early disclosures to medical professionals are much more common than to other professionals. NDE researchers and clinicians have presented specific recommendations for adequate and supportive interactions with NDE patients, including "normalizing" the experience and its aftereffects. However, these guidelines are yet to be integrated into medical curricula through education and evidence-based practices. Even though abundant research has documented NDEs as a phenomenon with consistent characteristics and aftereffects, experiences that are demonstrably different from hallucinations, dreams, or mental illness, barriers to integration of NDE knowledge into clinical practice remain strong. We have investigated physicians' attitudes towards NDEs and their specific difficulties toward accepting, acknowledging, and addressing NDEs in their practice, and we will present concrete steps to help overcome this resistance.






